Directions by Air

Getting to The Greenbrier is now easier than ever with commercial and charter flights arriving daily at the **Greenbrier Valley Airport** (LWB) ~ served by Delta and Continental Airlines and located only 15 minutes away from The Greenbrier in Lewisburg, WV.

Delta Air Lines offers daily, nonstop flights from Atlanta (Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport, ATL) and New York (John F. Kennedy International Airport, JFK). And for your convenience, these new flights now allow easy daytime connection for guests visiting from across the country.

Continental Airlines offers weekend commercial flights via the Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE). Most flights connect Continental's extensive route structure to The Greenbrier from more than 130 cities in the midwest and northeast.

Other convenient airports are located in **Beckley** (BKW) and **Charleston** (CRW), West Virginia, and **Roanoke** (ROA), Virginia, with service provided by major carriers. Here are some distances from The Greenbrier:

- Beckley (BKW) is 55 miles or 53 minutes
- Roanoke (ROA) is 71 miles or 90 minutes
- Charleston (CRW) is 121 miles or 2 hours

Getting from the airport to The Greenbrier

It's customary at this meeting to use **rental cars** because there are off-property opportunities. That's **not** the case at the Greenbrier ~ once you enter the property there is little reason to leave {think *Hotel California* (*you can check out any time you please, but you can never leave*)}. The point is you might not need a rental car. Directions by Train

Amtrak offers regular service to The Greenbrier from major cities, including Chicago, Cincinnati, Washington D.C. and New York City.
