

FTC Ban on Noncompetes Blocked

On August 20, 2024, a federal judge ruled the U.S. Federal Trade Commission (FTC) can't enforce its near total <u>ban on noncompete agreements</u> that was set to go into effect next month.

In the ruling, U.S. District Judge Ada Brown in Dallas sided with the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and a Texas-based tax firm that sued to block the measure.
